BIOGRAPHY

Matthew Rogers is an award-winning film composer, producer and multi-instrumentalist. As a film composer he has composed over 41 soundtracks for feature films, and 9 television series. He has **7 Leo Awards**, **14 Leo nominations**, and **2 ASCAP Screen Awards**.

In the past decade Matthew has also worked as a producer and arranger on over forty albums. His work has won five Western Canadian Music Awards. His own group, the renowned blues duo, **The Harpoonist & the Axe Murderer** has won three Western Canadian Music Awards, and have been nominated for 2 Juno Awards, and six Maple Blues Awards. They have just completed recording a live album using the legendary Rolling Stones mobile recording studio.

Last year, Matt is currently scoring the 4th season of **FAMILY LAW** (Global) as well as the horror feature and his latest series **SAFEHAVEN** will be coming to Crackle in 2024.
